What is a trigger point injection?

Trigger point injection can help relieve tender muscle areas that are painful to touch. Injection is made with a small amount of local anesthetic (numbing medication) and/or a steroid (antiinflammatory) into the painful site. The local anesthetic will numb the area, relieve the pain, and decrease the muscle spasm. The steroid will decrease inflammation.

What is the goal of a trigger point injection?

The goal is to provide pain relief so that you are able to resume normal activities.
